

Flag of Côte d'Ivoire




Commander's Message Cdr. Ron Schwartz, SN




A delightful spot to kayak or canoe and swim, about a 40 minute drive from Ann Arbor, in the Pinckney State Receation Area, is a group of interconnected lakes north of Chelsea, Michigan, on the Washtenaw/ Livingston county border. Blind Lake, Bruin Lake, Halfmoon Lake, Patterson Lake, Watson Lake and Woodburn Lake. There is a launch site at Halfmoon Lake Beach, and another at Bruin Lake Campground on the northwest side of Bruin Lake, and a Boy Scout Camp Munhacke on the southeast side of Bruin Lake. This would be a great place for a rendezvous.

At the April meeting I talked about how the new Panama Canal lock will alter the American transportation system. The new lock, scheduled to open in June, will allow the larger New Panamax freighters to transit to East Coast ports such as Charleston, Norfolk, Baltimore, and the New York area bypassing the busy Los Angeles and Long Beach ports. Union Pacific Railroad has developed their Golden State Route from the Midwest as a superb, fast track to serve the Los Angeles/Long Beach area. The same is true for Burlington Northern Santa Fe's Transcon route. But with the opening of the new lock, these marvels of modern railroad service could lose their traffic volume, becoming partially superfluous.

The National Maritime Museum in Toledo will again make the deck of the museum ship, the Col James M Schoonmaker available to view the Toledo fireworks display on the 4th of July. This is a one-of-a-kind experience for museum members only. The museum recommends advance reservations by calling (419) 214-5000, extension 200 for this holiday tradition. Last year on a lovely July night, we carried our folding chairs and picnic dinner up onto the dock of the Schoonmaker. The hatch covers made an excellent picnic table. As the display started, we rose for the National Anthem, then observed the magnificent display while listening to Tchaikovsky's 1812 Overture. The Museum was open and restrooms available until the start of the display.

The Museum has a full program of summer activities, for example cruises to Put-in-Bay, Detroit River trips. Members have access to all of the information through their publication, The Chadburn.
