


Commander's Message Cdr. Ron Schwartz, SN

Wamplers Lake and Hayes State Park



Walter J. Hayes State Park on southeast corner of Wamplers Lake is on US -12 and M -124 about 25 miles south west of Ann Arbor. The shallow launch site has 3 launch spaces with parking for over 60 cars and trailers. The beach has parking for over 400 cars. The lake is about 2/3 mile wide by 2 miles long. Joseph Wampler was one of the surveyers who, in 1824, surveyed the North South Meridian and Baseline in the area for establishing Townships in Michigan. Wamplers Lake is quite shallow --- 39' deep maximum. The launch site is shallow and sand bottom. Michigan Inland Lake Charts can be seen and down loaded at https://www.michigan.gov/dnr/0,4570,7-350-79119_79146_81198_85509---,00.html Wamplers Lake level is limited by a dam in the stream -- see below -- exiting the lake. (Goggle Earth picture). Two streams feed water into the lake -- one from Round Lake near the launch site at the state park, and one on the south side from Iron Lake passes next to Jerry's Pub and Restaurant.
